

Illinois College of Optometry Residence Complex

The Residence Complex (RC) is a smoke-free and drug free facility located at 3241 South Indiana Avenue. A suite includes one double room, one single room, and one bathroom. Two people occupy the double room and one person occupies the single room. All three people share the bathroom.

Double room in Suite arrangement - \$900 per person for the 6 weeks
Single room in Suite arrangement - \$1,050 for the 6 weeks

Residents must supply all linens (including pillow), food, etc. The RC is a safe and secure complex with 24/7 Security.

Suites

Every bedroom is furnished with an extra-long twin bed that includes under-bed storage, a study desk with built-in lighting and corkboard, a dresser, a closet, and a bedside lamp. Each resident is supplied with telephone, cable television (TV not supplied), and high-speed Internet access. Suites include a double and single bedroom. Each suite has a private bathroom, which includes a shower, toilet, and sink. Residents are responsible for other appliances, laundering, and cleaning. A coin-operated laundry (\$1.00 to wash and \$1.00 to dry each load) is located on the 1st floor of the RC.

A phone is available in each room to make on-campus calls. To make off-campus calls, you must use a personal cell phone, "world wide" calling card, or call collect to place local or long distance phone calls.

There is a recreational lounge on each floor equipped with a TV/VCR/DVD as well as with microwaves (1st – 4th floors), mini fridges (2nd – 4th floors).

Check-in is Sunday, June 20, 2010 - Noon to 5:00 p.m.

Check-out is Monday, August 1, 2010 - Noon to 5:00 p.m.
