

HOW TO GET TO VANDERCOOK COLLEGE OF MUSIC

VanderCook College of Music lies three miles south of downtown Chicago on the campus of the Illinois Institute of Technology.

BY CAR from the north or west:

Exit Interstate 90/94 at 31st Street. Continue straight to 33rd Street and turn left. Cross the expressway, pass under the railroad tracks and turn left on Federal. VanderCook is about 250 yards on the left.

BY CAR from the south:

Exit I-90/94 at 35th Street. Continue straight to 33rd Street and turn right. Pass under the railroad tracks and turn left on Federal. VanderCook is about 250 yards on the left.

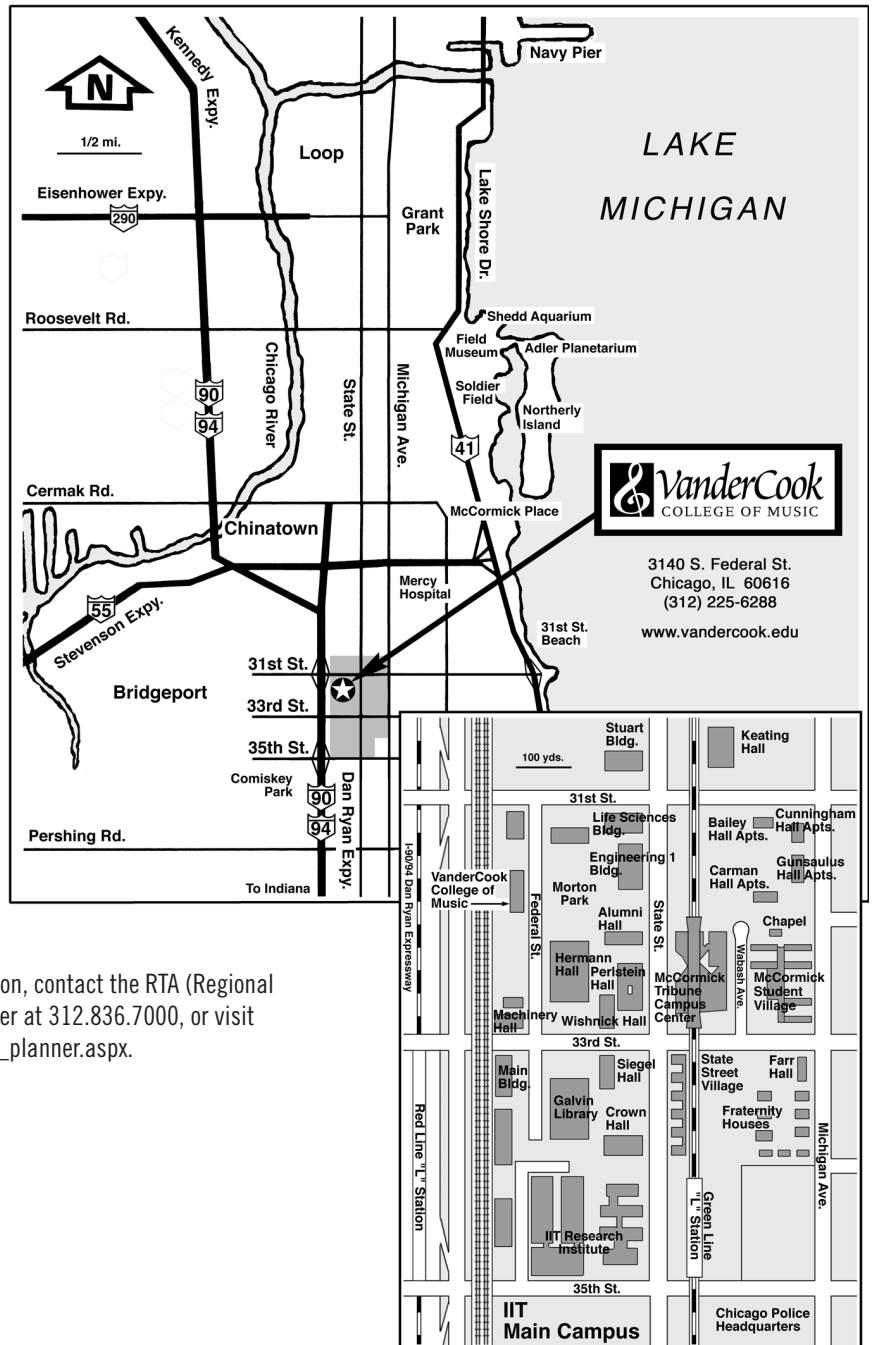
BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION:

Two elevated CTA railway stations are within a short walk of VanderCook: the 35th/Bronzeville station on the Green Line and the 35th/Sox station on the Red Line. Many bus routes also operate in the vicinity.

BY TRAIN:

The Rock Island Line of the Metra commuter rail system stops within four blocks of the college, at the 35th St./'Lou' Jones/Bronzeville station. The Rock Island Line connects to the LaSalle Street Station in downtown Chicago.
