Credit: *Chicago Area Kodály Educators (CAKE) 2018-2019 Workshop Series* may be taken for one (1) graduate credit. To earn graduate credit for the *Chicago Area Kodály Educators (CAKE) 2018-2019 Workshop Series*, a participant must attend four sessions (12.5 hours) during the workshop series. Students must attend all four scheduled sessions to earn credit.

Course Exit Requirement: PLEASE READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY! A notebook summarizing and critiquing all sessions attended must be compiled. The notebook should include copies of all handouts, programs, and any other supporting materials. The notebook should be mailed to Patrick Benson, Director of Continuing and Online Education, VanderCook College of Music, 3140 S. Federal St. Chicago, IL 60616, for evaluation and grading. In addition to summary and critique, the notebook should include reflections on how the information presented will impact one's teaching, programming, and/or classroom instruction. Guidelines for Notebook

Materials Needed

- Three-ringed notebook - size that is appropriate for materials
- Tabbed dividers - quantity that is appropriate for materials

Parameters

- Include a title page stating course number and title, your name, address, phone, email, and the term (Fall 2018).
- Table of Contents
- Page Numbers
- All information must be typed and neatly formatted in a manner befitting graduate credit. Handwritten work will not be accepted.
- Full sentences, and correct grammar and spelling are required.
- All handouts and supporting materials must be included.

Notebook Due Date: Please submit notebooks to Patrick Benson no later than May 6, 2019, one month after the final CAKE session in the 2018-2019 series has taken place. Notebooks must be postmarked by this date. Notebooks will be mailed back to students after grading.

Dates and Location: Workshop sessions take place on Saturday, September 8, 2018, Saturday, November 17, 2019, Saturday, March 2, 2019, and Saturday, April 13, 2019. All workshops will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. The workshop on November 17th, 2018 will be held at Old Town School of Folk Music from 9:30-1:30pm
